Brief introduction of J-STAGE/JaLC

J-STAGE is an online platform for Japanese journals.

Approximately 6 million articles are available from 4,000 journals.

JaLC was established as a registration agency to assign DOIs to Japanese content.

J-STAGE started in 1999, around the same time as Crossref.

J-STAGE joined Crossref in 2002.
